FAQs



<p>What are the eligibility criteria?</p>	<p>You must be either a current TEC/TECR/KEY/TAS/TPP member OR a TEC Alumnus who has been an active CEO within the past 18 months.</p> <p>You must be nominated by a current TEC Chair and your current or past TEC group members.</p>
<p>How long should my presentation be?</p>	<p>You will have 20 minutes to present. This time includes any workshop elements for your topic. Your presentation will be followed by a 5-minute table discussion which will include rapid recall. You will also have a 15-minute audience Q&A session with 1-2 of the other speakers within your speaker time-block.</p>
<p>Will I receive payment for presenting?</p>	<p>An honorarium will be paid to you or a charity of your choice if you are chosen to present at All TEC Day 2010. TEC will also pay your travel and accommodation if you are presenting in other cities.</p>
<p>Will I have to present at all ATD events around the country?</p>	<p>Initially you are selected to present in your capital city only; however, you may be invited to present in other capital cities around Australia and in Auckland, New Zealand. This is why we need to know if you are available in the first 3 weeks of September and are willing to travel interstate. Also, you don't need to accept the invitation to present in other states if you only wish to present in your home state.</p> <p>The dates and ATD locations are as follows: Monday September 6 – Auckland Hyatt Regency Thursday September 9 – Melbourne Convention & Exhibition Centre Friday September 10 – Adelaide Intercontinental Hotel Monday September 13 – Perth Burswood Convention Centre Wednesday September 15 – Sydney Convention & Exhibition Centre Friday September 17 – Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre</p> <p>Only nominate if you are available during this period.</p>
<p>When do I need to submit my nomination by? And who to?</p>	<p>All nominations are due before 31 March 2010. Please send by email to Lisa Cook at TEC – lisacook@tec.com.au</p>

<p>What are the selection criteria?</p>	<p>Initially we would like you to ask yourself these questions:</p> <p>Do I have a business or personal story that will inspire, motivate, entertain and change fellow members? Will it engage other members? Did it engage the members in my group? Am I capable of presenting to and engaging a large audience? Would my Chair and fellow group members support me in this endeavour?</p> <p>If you answer positively to these questions, you should submit a nomination.</p> <p>TEC will undertake a review of all the nominations received in March & April 2010. During this process we will evaluate your nomination based on the following:</p> <p>Is your story interesting? Is it relevant and relatable to other members? Are there tangible results that demonstrate the outcomes? Is there clear take-away value for other members? How powerful is the take-away? Will it inspire and members to action?</p> <p>A final decision will be made on these and other discretionary criteria, including the mix of stories we would want to include at any one event.</p>
<p>Do I need to prepare a handout?</p>	<p>If you are accepted as one of TEC's ATD speakers, a brief handout detailing your presentation's key points and takeaway (including any relevant tools and templates) will be required.</p>
<p>Will my presentation be recorded?</p>	<p>Yes. You will be video recorded at the ATD event. TEC will use this recording for non-commercial purposes. Please contact TEC for more details on this.</p>
<p>What if I am selected to present and then need to cancel my presentation?</p>	<p>We understand that you are CEOs and may need to cancel your presentation due to unforeseen circumstances. While TEC will have contingency plans in place, we kindly ask that once you have committed to being an ATD presenter that</p>

What other time commitment is involved?	Depending on your progress through the selection process, there are various aspects that will require you to commit time to. These would involve presentation preparation work including presentation structure and content, topic outline and handout, tools and/or templates, and determining your required audio visual requirements; presenting at your group meeting in July; participating in a full rehearsal in August; and, of course, participation at the full ATD event(s).
